Proposed itinerary -

Timings are approx at this stage & will be confirmed nearer the time

06.00am Coach departs Sheffield (meet at Penny Black, Pond Hill)

10.30am— 11:00am Coach arrives at Westminster

11:00am— 11:15am Clear security

11:45am approx Expert guided tours of Parliament

(tours in groups of 25 - approximate duration of tour is 75 mins)

12.45 - 2pm LUNCH

2.20 - 2.30pm Speaker's Procession through Central Lobby

2.30 - 4.00pm Public Gallery - *we hope to obtain tickets for everyone!*

4.00 - 5.00pm Meeting with Paul Blomfield MP

6.00pm Coach departs Westminster

10.30pm Coach arrives Sheffield

Travel will be by coach with a toilet. The journey down will be an 'express' journey - no planned stop on the way down - so please bring drinks and food with you!

On the return journey we will stop at a service station and this will be a 'meal break' stop.

The tours are on foot and generally of around 75 minutes in duration and are 'full' tours which visit the Chambers of both the House of Commons and House of Lords. Quite a lot of walking is involved!
